



## Mopar Muscle Cars of Austin

### Random Thoughts & Club Happenings

---

Here we are again, heading into the dog days of an Austin summer! I know, spring isn't over yet but as hot as its been in my garage I feel entitled to start talking about summer. I hope everyone's projects are coming along well. I spoke with Terry Siegmund last week and I know he's been doing quite a bit of the heavy welding (floor pan, firewall, etc.) on his 67 Hemi GTX. The last word I got was that he had turned it around in the garage in order to begin welding on the right rear quarter. As for me, well my "2 weekend" cam swap in the '69 Coronet R/T has taken on a life of its own. All in all, I'm glad because I found a LOT of problems in there that I would never have guessed based on the way the 440 Magnum was running. Specifically, 12 out of 16 bent pushrods and a cam that was installed *extremely* retarded. I assume that the bent pushrods occurred when the factory timing gear failed on some previous owner. When I got the car, it had an aftermarket timing set which I replaced with a double-roller set. At that time, I just aligned the marks and let 'er go. The car ran quite well until I lost a cam lobe in February of this year- which is what started the whole project. Since I was planning on carefully degreasing-in my MP repro Magnum cam, I decided to practice on the old cam. Wow! on top of the bent pushrods, the cam was installed at 119°. Recommended centerline for the Magnum cam is 113°. I guess the fact that the cam worked as well as it did is a testament to the flexibility of the dual-pattern Magnum cam. Single-pattern cams like the MP 509 and "street Hemi grind" don't work well at all if they are

installed overly retarded. The Magnum cam likes a little more retard (113 instead of 106 degrees) but is apparently also much less sensitive to mis-alignment. Just to be safe, the new cam is in at 113 degrees, thanks to a set of MP offset bushings. Now if I could just persuade the machine shop to finish up reworking the 906 heads, I'd be ready to button it back up!

One of the things I often hear about the modern Chrysler car and truck lineup is, "Gee, I WISH they'd make a Ramcharger out of the new Ram pickup." Well, take a look at this picture:



Before anyone asks, NO, I did NOT doctor a picture up with Photoshop software! This is an actual 1999 Dodge Ramcharger. The only problem is, its only sold in Mexico. This picture came from the Chrysler Mexico website (<http://www.chrysler.com.mx>). If you have a chance, you might want to go check out that website. They have several interesting vehicles on the market in Mexico that can't be had in the US. How about a 16-valve turbocharged version of the Dodge Stratus? Sounds like a nice successor to the Daytona IROC R/T, doesn't it? Unfortunately, even in Mexico there is no rear-drive V8-powered muscle car.

There aren't a lot of shows coming up for the next couple of months. Exceptions include the Charger meet in Boerne on June 5<sup>th</sup> and the Fredericksburg Swap Meet in July. Kars for Kids was very good this year- definitely an improvement over last year. Turnout was up significantly, and Carol Neal told me that the last word she heard was that over \$20,000 was raised for the children's charity. The show is going on and congratulations to the new management! I for one plan to be there again next year. It was also great to see the Twins at the show in that shiny Green Charger. I dare you to get the other two painted for next year, guys (ducking and running for cover!)

I apologize for the late notice about the Blanco Classic Car show, but it *really* wasn't my fault! Honest! The show simply wasn't very well promoted. We didn't get the registration forms in the club PO box until *after* the deadline for pre-registration had expired. I did take my wife and

daughter out to the show, and I entered the daily driver in place of the very dis-assembled convertible. I have to say that the Blanco show is one of the best, if not *the* best shows in this area for families. My 5-year old was able to take her baseball and bat (among other items) and get together with other kids in the park for games and a picnic while the show was going on. The park is absolutely beautiful and a whole lot cooler and more comfortable than a dealership parking lot. There were fairly few Mopars entered, about a dozen divided between the “Mopar” class and the “Muscle Car” class plus a few in the antique and one street rod. Yes, I did say there was a Mopar street rod, and no I don’t mean a Plymouth coupe with a Chove-a-lot 350 engine. Many hours had gone into the beautiful wood-strip and metal bed on this truck, and it was a real crowd-pleaser. We headed home at about 2:30 and awards weren’t until 4 so I don’t know if the truck earned a trophy or not. Heck, I’d have given it one just for being non-Chevy-powered!
